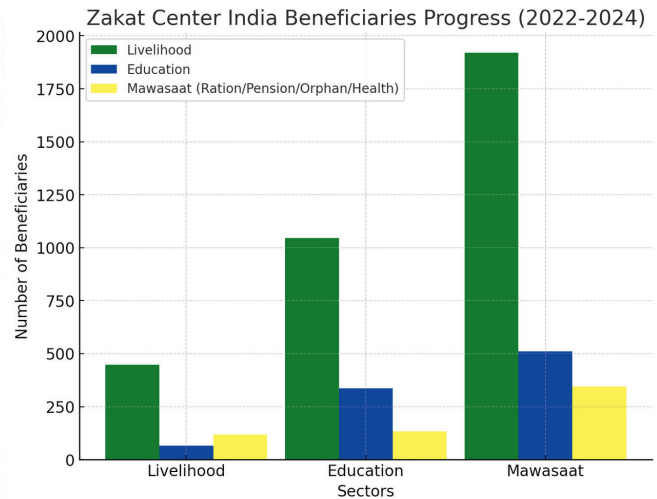
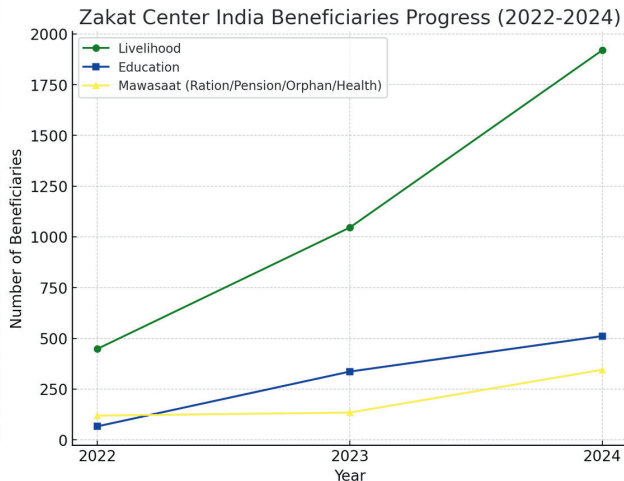

that's 93.6%!



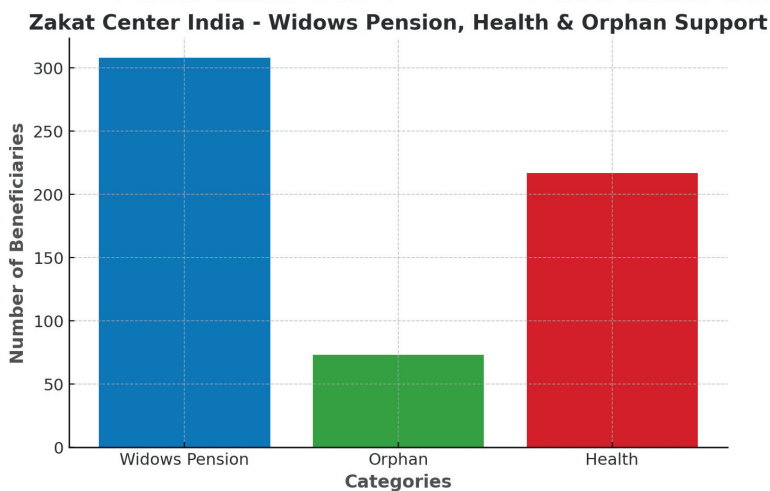
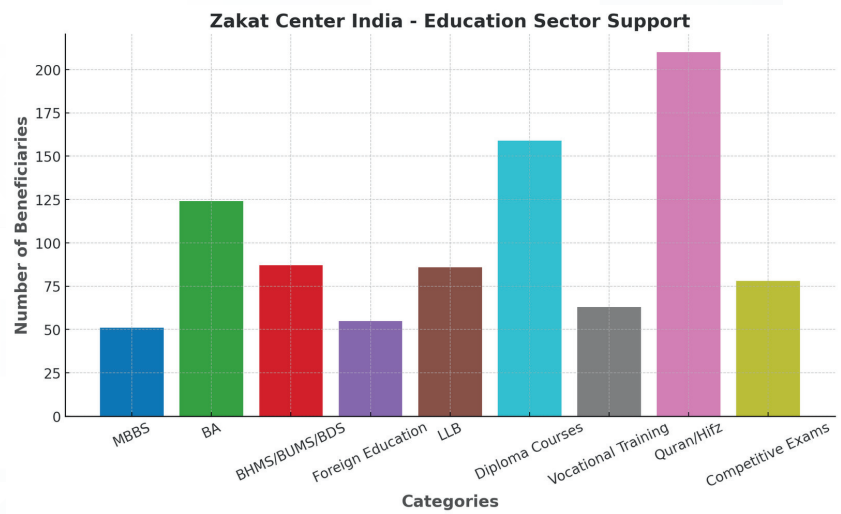
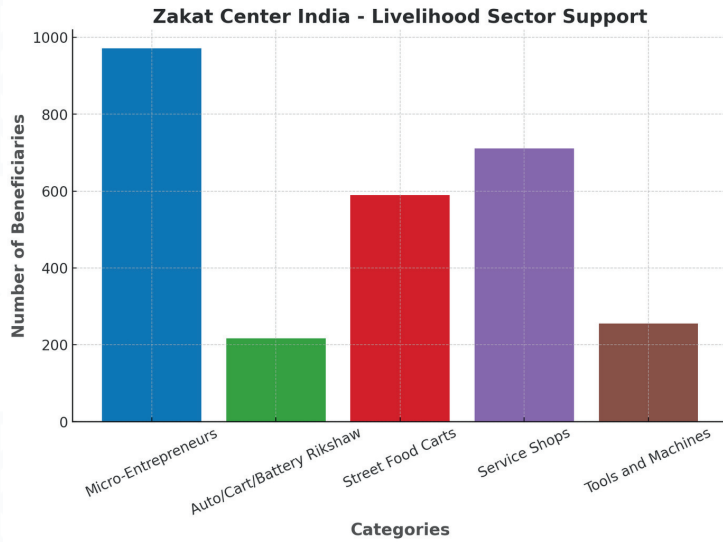
Has the money we gave helped you to get your finances back on track?

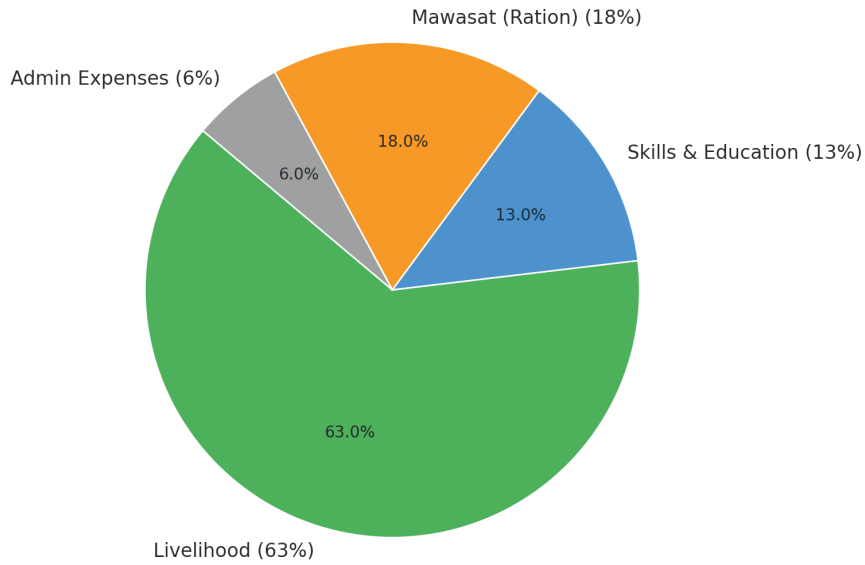
Using Zakat Funds in Productive schemes instead of Consumptive



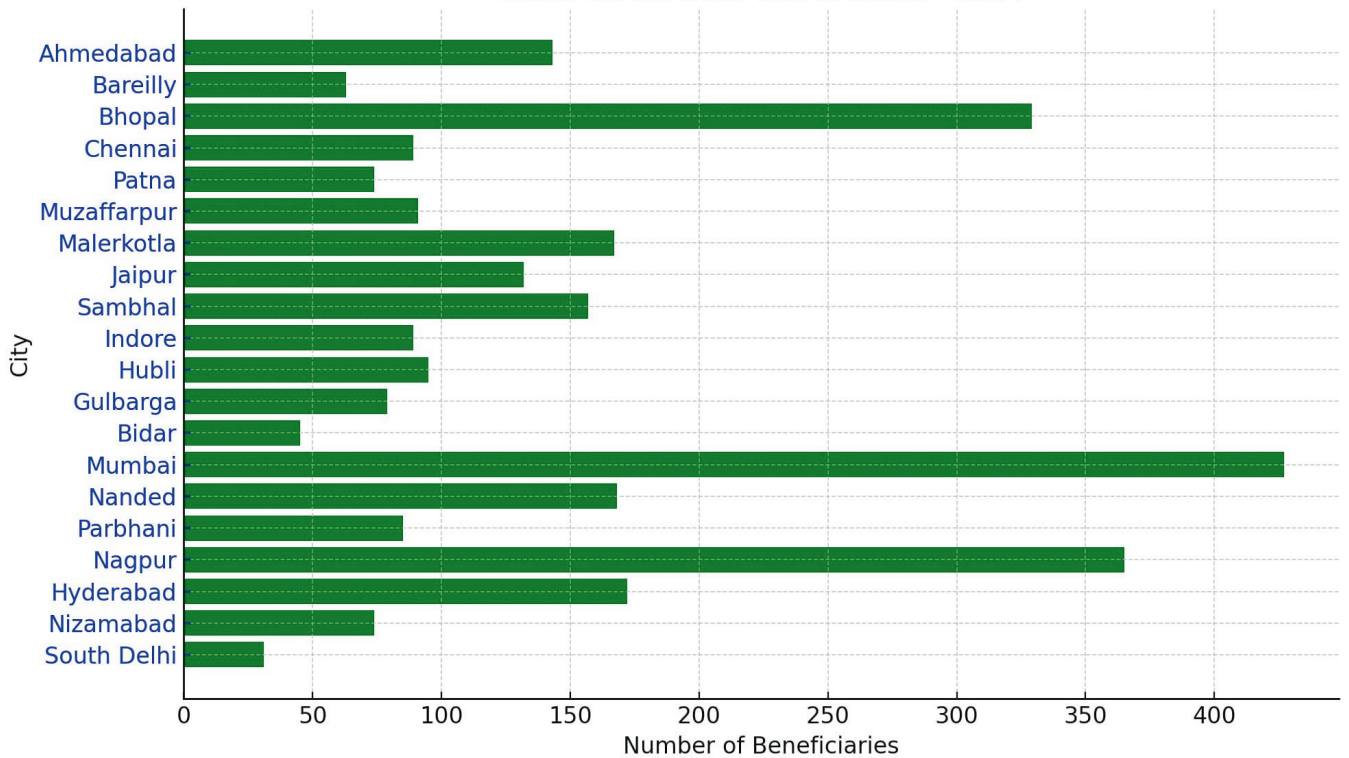
We use all Zakat for charitable activity.

We do not use Zakat to raise funds or for core costs.

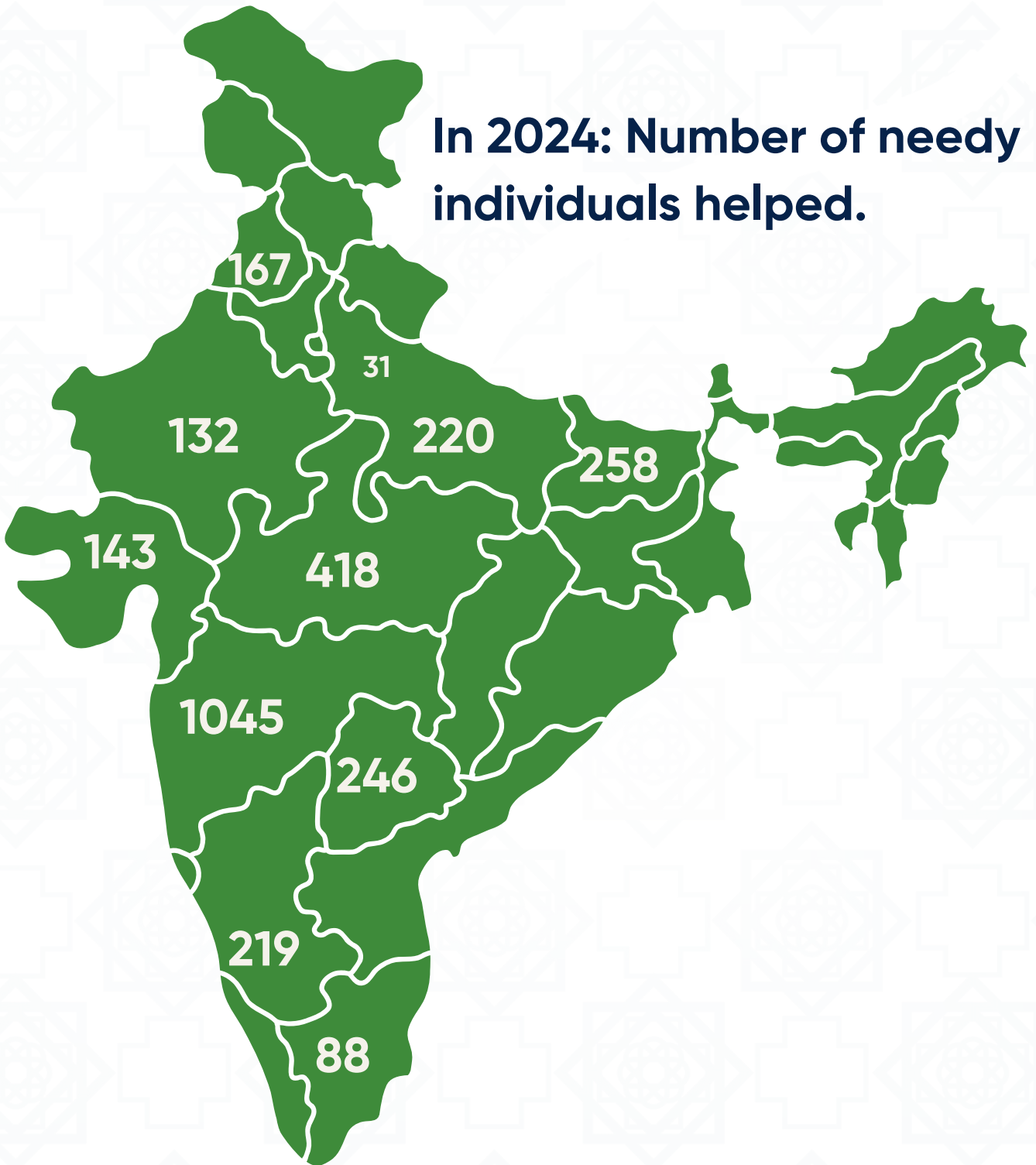
Disbursement Breakdown in 2024

In 2024: Number of needy individuals helped.



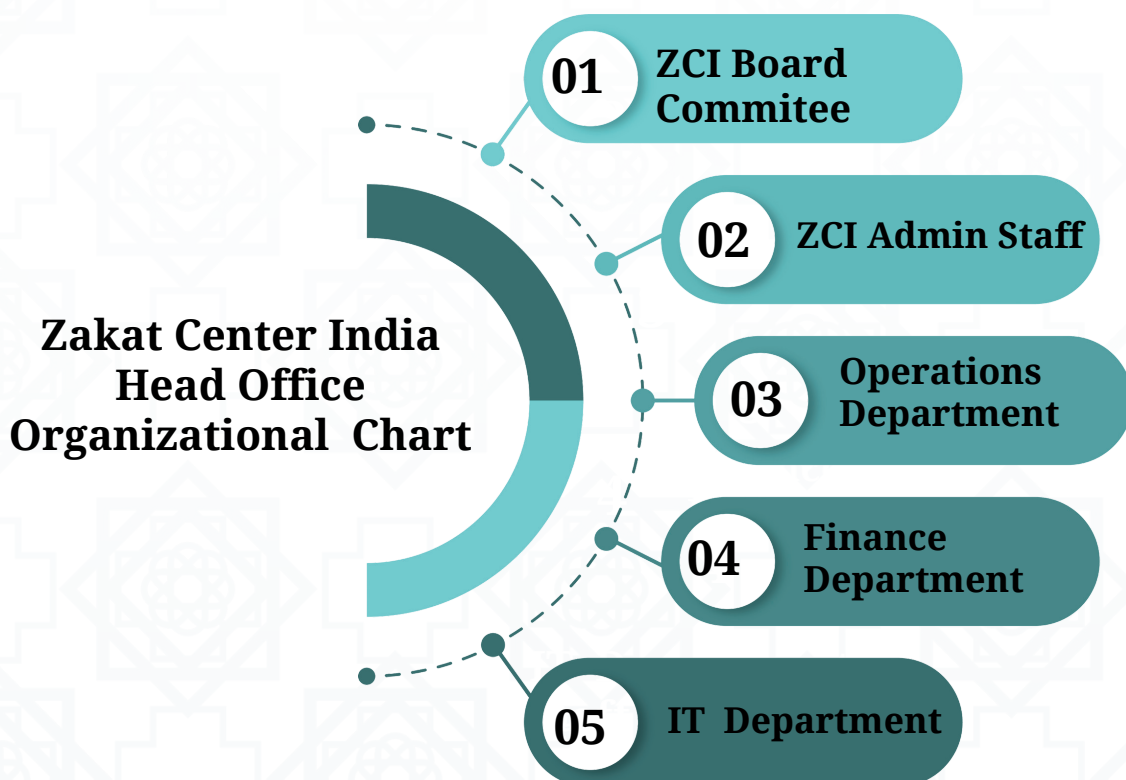
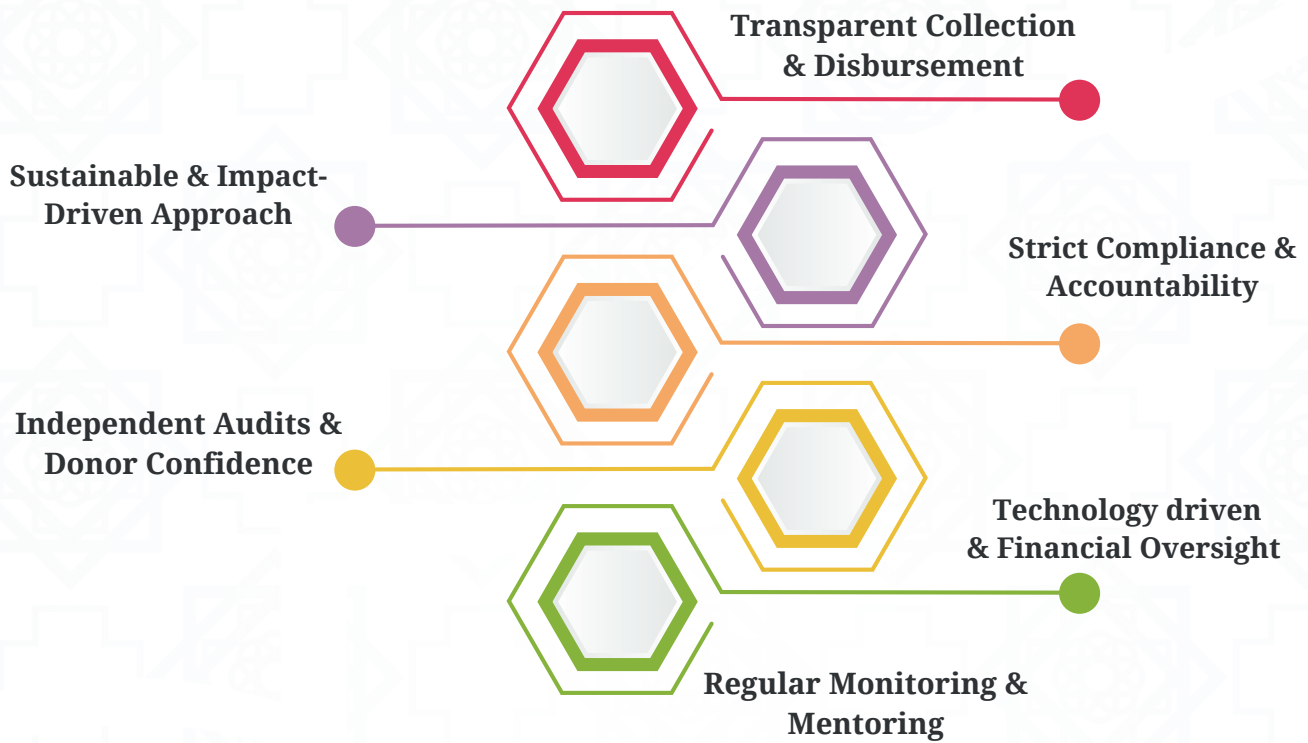

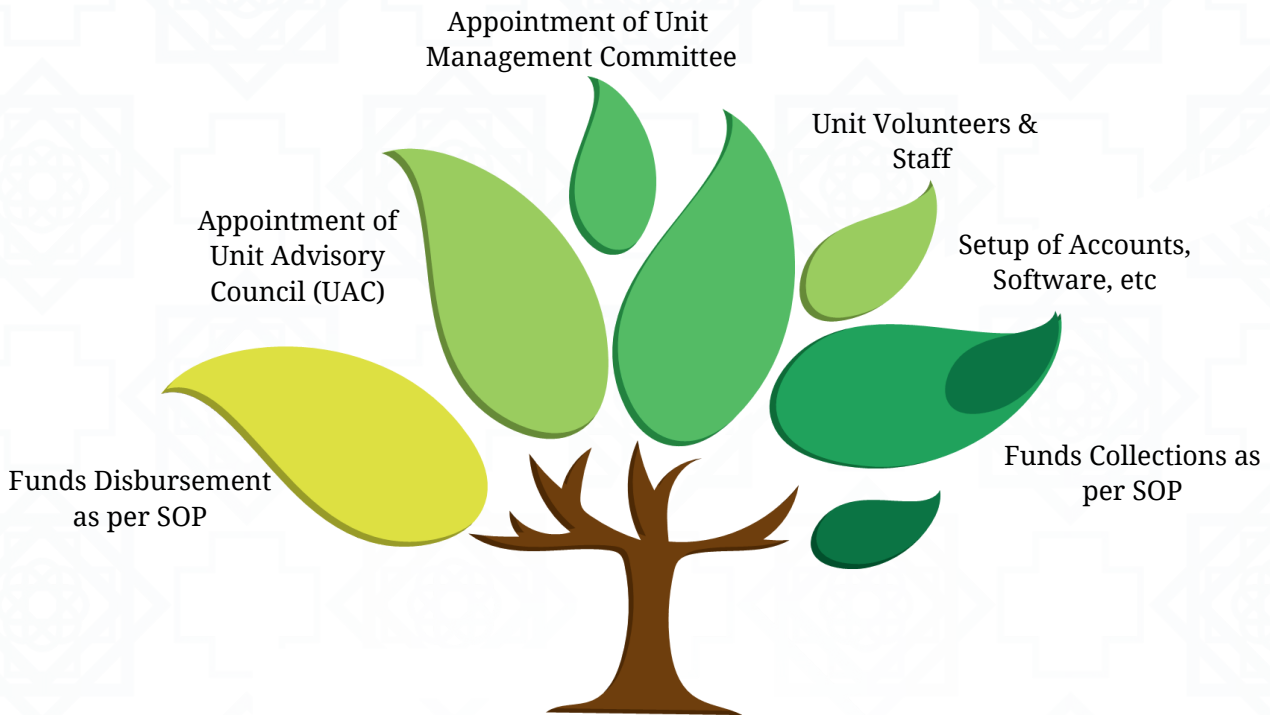

Maqbool Hurzuk

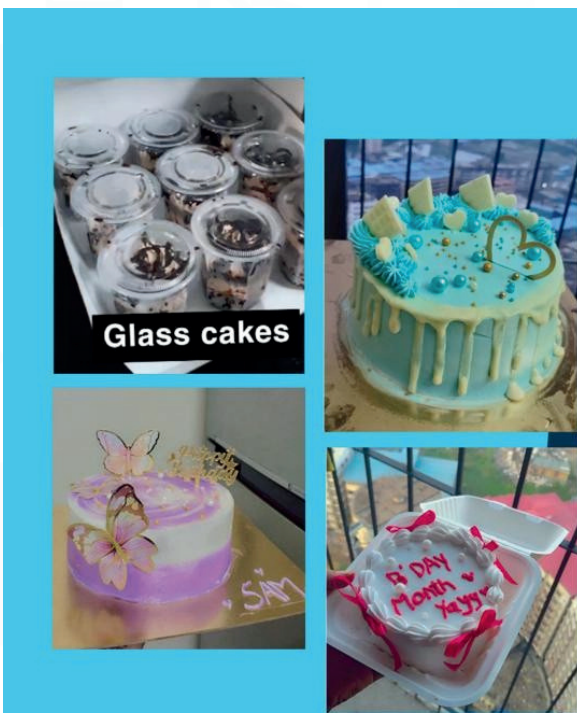
